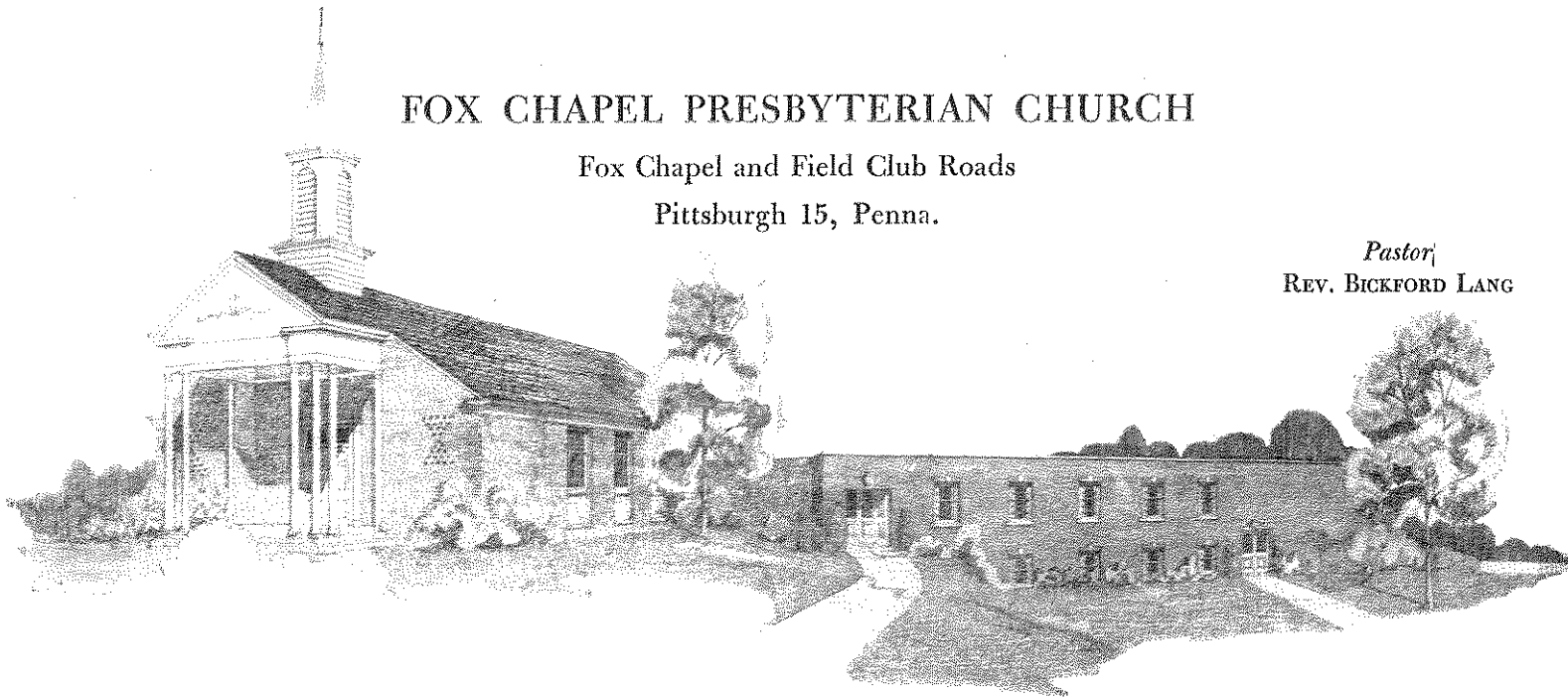

TO ALL MEMBERS AND FRIENDS:

Greetings in the name of Our Lord whose blessing and approval for our enterprise is proven by several "History-Making" events, such as:

- I. On October 4, though not officially organized, 188 took Communion.
- II. On October 11, the congregation was officially organized by the Presbytery of Pittsburgh with over 300 CHARTER MEMBERS. This is an unusual record for a "New Church," within eight months after the Pastor came on the field.
- III. On October 18, the Cornerstone was placed into the Chapel, and ground was broken for the Educational Building. Construction on this second unit is to begin as soon as funds are available.
- IV. The officers of the newly organized congregation have officially authorized a Fund-raising program to begin Nov. 1. The goal is set at \$350,000 to cover the cost of the Chapel and the Educational Building.

THE NEXT HISTORIC STEP will be the Financial canvass.
