# Music at FCPC I

#### From the Minister of Music

Grace has been on my mind as of late. First entering my mind surrounding communion. At our most recent All Saint's Sunday, one of the congregational hymns was "Come to the Table of Grace". We approach God's table not because of anything that we have done ourselves, but rather because of the extraordinary grace bestowed on us from God our Creator through Jesus Christ.

This week, I find myself just as stuck on the concept of grace. In baptism, we are again shown grace. As parents bring their children, often too young to even know what is happening, we see the glorious gift of God's grace. For the child is covered in God's grace even before knowing what grace is.

This week's hymn at the procession is "Jesus, Lover of My Soul". This hymn by Charles Wesly was written following Wesly's conversion. I was particularly drawn to this hymn as this week's opener because of the text found in the fourth verse which reads, "Plenteous grace with thee is found, grace to cover all my sin." How beautiful it is that we bear witness to just how abundant God's grace is that it covers us even when we have no knowledge of it.

So, as we sing this week, "Jesus, Lover of My Soul", let us not forget God's all-encompassing grace that covers us.
