Dorseyville Middle School; and 3) Sharpsburg Food Pantry located in the basement of St Mary's Church.

Thank you to everyone who has recently donated non-perishable food items to the designated bins located by either the Front Desk or downstairs, outside Fellowship Hall. These donations are regularly transported by the Deacons to 3 local food pantries. One of these food pantries is Bread of Life located in Etna. Last year, Bread of Life served over 1,500 families; this accounted for 3,236 individuals; 165 veterans and 547 disabled individuals. As we are all aware, the number of families and individuals in need of food has significantly increased in 2025. Please continue to purchase non-perishable healthy foods for those in need. Room 107. A place to comfort or feed a child and watch the worship service.


