#### **GREAT THANKSGIVING**


The Lord be with you. And also with you.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. It is right to give our thanks and praise.


Blessing God, you walk with us from the Jerusalem of our failure...

# For Children and Families during 11am Worship

Children of all ages are welcome to remain in worship with their families, and we provide the following opportunities for children and families:

Children age 3 to 5th grade are invited to sign up for Kids' Church prior to worship near the entry to the Sanctuary. Children may join Pastor Lori at the front of the Sanctuary for a Children's Message during worship (except on the first Sunday of the month). Following the Children's Message, children are led to the lowest level Kids' Space, where parents/guardians can pick them up following worship. The lowest level is accessed via the elevator in the Atrium or the staircase near the main entrance.

Nursery care is available for ages 0-3 in Room 109 (near the main entrance).

**The Comfort Space** is available in Room 107 (next to the nursery) to comfort or feed a child and watch the worship service via livestream.

# The Great Fifty Days (Second Sunday after Easter)

### **NAIL-PRINT HANDS** LUKE 24:36-40

This is the day we remember Christ's appearance to the "doubting Thomas." When Cleopas and Mary told the disciples how Jesus had revealed himself to them, Thomas was not there. When he did hear the story from the other disciples he did not believe them and said that he would not until he could put his own finger into the wounds on Jesus' hand. A week later, Jesus appeared to Thomas, and Thomas fell to his knees and exclaimed, "My Lord and my God!" Seeing was believing.
