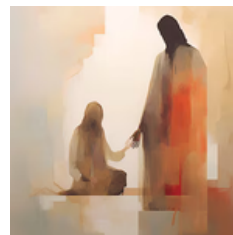

As I reflect on last weekend's concert, what continues to come to the very top of my mind is overwhelming gratitude. We are a congregation that worships in many different ways, and we are blessed to have many gifted people that help us to worship in those diverse ways. Whether it be with the Chancel Choir and organ at 11:00, the Contemporary Worship Band at 9:30, or you are an early riser and choose to commune at 8:15; you have experienced the leadership of many people coming together that have planned and prayed that our worship to God be truly inspired.

Our church boasts a growing Children's Choir of dedicated families that commit to bringing their children to rehearsals, extra practices, and services they lead. We have a group of dedicated bell ringers that practice weekly to add that special sparkle that only bells can to services. This year we launched the Choral Scholar Program which invites high school singers to participate in the Chancel Choir and in return pays a small stipend to the scholars. This coming season we are excited to offer a Cherub Choir that will give our youngest singers (3yrs-kindergarten) a place to learn and sing together.

There is much happening in the department, and there is no way any of this would be possible without you. This year's concert, *Glory to God: Our Song Faith* was all about singing our faith and I had invited us all to join in the song. Through the many generous financial contributions, through the many words of encouragement, through your prayers, through your very presence, you have heeded that call to take your part in the song. And for that I am more grateful than words can share.

I am also immensely grateful for the Fellowship Committee that hosted a lovely reception following the concert, for the office and caretaking staff whose work made the logistics of the day happen, and for all of the musicians that I had the privilege of sharing in this music making journey.

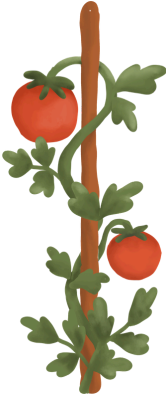
