

### From the Minister of Music

#### **NOTE ON TODAY'S ANTHEM**

"Let the amen sound from God's people again!"

Perhaps one of my absolute favorite lines in Christian hymnody and the reason "Praise Ye the Lord, the Almighty!" is one of my favorite hymns. The line draws such a beautiful picture of the mighty congregation lifting their voices together in praise and adoration to their creator.

Originally written in 1680 by Joachim Neander (a German theologian, teacher, and writer), this well known and loved hymn was translated into English 1863 by Catherine Winkworth. It was at this point that the hymn became widely known and song in congregations in the United States.

The tune, LOBE DEN HERREN, is equally uplifting with its strong, confident melody invites congregations to sing together with energy. Each verse encourages worshipers to remember God's goodness, protection, providence, and steadfast love in every season of life.

This hymn is still inspiring musicians to arrange this hymn in new and creative ways. The Chancel Choir will be offering a wonderful arrangement of Cindy Berry that sets the tune in a festive and celebratory style. Keeping the harmonies very similar to the commonly known congregational hymn, Berry also pulls from arrangers of this hymn from that past such as F. Melius Christiansen of the famed St. Olaf Choir.




