Attention all FCPC men - mark your calendars!!

The 2025 Fox Chapel Men's Group retreat will be held again this year on October 10 through October 12 at the Antiochian Retreat Center in Ligonier. This year's theme is "Wisdom from Above: Old Voices on New Questions. Living well in a world of difficult people." The Rev. Dr. Rafael Rodriguez will join us as our guest speaker and will be exploring his new book *The First Christian Letters*, a discourse on 1st and 2nd Thessalonians.

In addition to our Friday evening / all day Saturday / Sunday morning rate with rooms, meals, and the complete line up of events, we are now also offering a Commuter Rate for those that can only attend the event on Saturday, October 11. This will include the full Saturday Thessalonians bible study and seminar with Rafael, along with breakfast, lunch, and dinner events that day as the individual is able. The Commuter rate is \$150 for the full day. The full three-day event single room accommodation rate is \$354 and the three-day double room accommodation rate is \$288.

For those attending the full event, the agenda includes a Friday evening social with appetizers (some hot from the Center, some brought by us all), and BYOB as desired. In additional to all the Saturday meals and Sunday breakfast, we have the popular Saturday evening bonfire and dinner event on the agenda again this year, and our Sunday Services and Communion will be led by Rafael and conducted in the Antiochian Chapel.

This is a great time and place for a man to recenter his walk with Christ and with other Christian men. It is a time to explore God's word and your heart with a leading bible scholar and other church men.

A Message from S.C. Toe, Minister of Music


Hunger Garden Volunteers



opportunities for our children and families. And of course, we'll continue our weekly Kids' Church lessons each Sunday!


